

Instructions for use

To read first

- The innovative YD-Woods® graphic panel is exclusively intended for indoor use where contact with splash water or condensation is of very short duration.
- YD-Woods® is not structural and is not suitable for use in bathrooms and other wet rooms.
- Wood has dimensional movements (shrinkage/swelling) under the effect of humidity variations.
- In order to prevent any inconvenience, **it is imperative to observe the following recommendations.**

1. Storage

- Store the wrapped YD-Woods® panels flat on top of each other in a dry, enclosed area. Insulate from the ground by laying them on battens spaced 1 m apart and oriented widthwise.
- Only remove the plastic film when applying the finish.
- Handle YD-Woods® panels with care, as the panel's design (grain wood - end wood) makes it fragile before installation.

2. Cut-outs

- In order not to weaken the YD-Woods® panel, only one cut should be made in the panel.
- Any cuts made in the panel should be compensated for by reinforcement or attachment to a support.

3. Finishing

- Apply the appropriate finish before installing and mounting the YD-Woods® panel, with a minimum of two coats (PU varnish finish for use on worktops). The finish must be identical (volume of product and number of coats) on each side and edge to balance the moisture content of the YD-Woods® panel.

4. Fixing

- For use as a work surface, leave a 3 to 5 mm gap between the YD-Woods® panel and the wall. Apply a silicone-type sealant to fill the gap.
- For use as a staircase step, use at least a 40 mm thick YD-Woods® panel. If the steps are cantilevered, it is essential to provide a metal reinforcement plate on the underside.
- For use as a table top, provide for the installation of stiffening cleats every 50 cm on the underside.
- When measuring the width of the panel, always trim the panel so that the final edges are made up of a ply of wire wood.

5. Use

- Appliances that generate heat (pots, pans, etc.) must not be placed directly on the YD-Woods® panel. Use a heat-resistant insert (trivet, etc.).
- Depending on the use and the finish applied, provide for adequate maintenance.
- As YD-Woods® is made of soft wood, impacts and sharp objects (heels, utensils, etc.) leave indelible marks.
