# Reduce our environmental footprint

At Ducerf, we optimize the use of wood and our resources to reduce our environmental impact. We act on several levers and also prioritize short supply chains for sourcing our sawmills, thereby limiting transport-related emissions and supporting the local economy. These actions are part of our **overall approach to reducing our carbon footprint**.

## Waste optimization

Groupe Ducerf is committed to more responsible consumption. This involves **optimizing the use of our waste** by converting it into energy, thereby reducing our overall consumption.

We also support our employees in waste sorting and reduction efforts, such as limiting paper usage and participating in collective recycling initiatives.

## Reduction of our pollution

Ducerf is actively committed to **reducing its fuel consumption and greenhouse gas emissions** by implementing a comprehensive **responsible mobility** policy and optimizing travel. This includes investing in more environmentally friendly vehicles, such as electric forklifts and cars, as well as hybrid vehicles selected for their optimal balance between weight and power.

The company also **encourages sustainable modes of transport** : employees are encouraged to prioritize walking or cycling across all production sites, and sales staff are prompted to optimize their routes, using trains or renting electric vehicles when possible. Carpooling is promoted as a collective mobility solution, and short supply chains are favored to minimize travel related to raw materials, consumables, or services whenever feasible.

Additionally, Ducerf allows employees to work from home one day per week to reduce commuting, and the **use of professional equipment** is carefully managed.

Finally, the company conducts **awareness initiatives on digital pollution**, aiming to act more broadly on all levers to reduce its carbon footprint.

## Mastering our consumption

Ducerf is committed to **controlling its electricity consumption** by acting on both behaviors and equipment. We raise employee awareness of daily eco-friendly practices and actively participate in demand response programs by temporarily reducing consumption during peak periods.

All our sites are gradually being equipped with LED lighting, and we have reorganized certain work periods, including breaks, to allow the shutdown of energy-intensive systems such as extraction installations. This approach reflects our commitment to **combining industrial performance with energy efficiency**.
